Although extra accommodation was obtained in adjacent houses during the Summer months, numerous applications from non-subscribers could not be entertained.

Finance. The Balance Sheet shows a small amount to the credit of the Maintenance Account.

Offertories. Thanks for Offertories received during the year are tendered to the Vicars of Benenden, Holmwood, Elham, and Clewer.

The Annual Sale of Work was held on 30th October, and despite the very unfavourable state of the weather that day, a sum of £98 9s. 2d. was realized towards the funds of the Home. Thanks are heartily accorded to all who assisted in various ways on the occasion.

Owing to illness amongst the staff of the Home, the usual special services on St. Andrew's Day, and the gathering of friends afterwards had unavoidably to be cancelled. Thanks are gratefully tendered to all those who would have made their offerings at the Services in the Chapel had it taken place, but who kindly remembered the Home and sent donations instead amounting to £14 1s.

It was hoped that the Reredos in the Chapel would have been finally completed by St. Andrew's Day. The two wings which were not *in situ* last year having now been added, the appearance of the Reredos is much enhanced thereby, but the figures (to fill the niches in the wings) of St. Andrew and St. John Baptist, have yet to come, the delay being that suitable alabaster has not yet been secured by the Sculptor, Mr. J. E. Taylorson.

The bath accommodation on the men's side of the building being inconvenient and insufficient, a lady has generously made a handsome donation towards adding another bath-room. The Council tender their sincere thanks to her for her kindness.

Whilst the alteration is being carried out, it is thought desirable to enlarge the Men's Smoking Room, which also has never provided adequate accommodation.

The Lift. The lift, which has been in use since the Home was first opened, is quite worn out, and will have to be entirely renewed.

On December 28th, the usual Christmas Entertainments took place. The proceedings commenced by the lighting up of the Christmas Tree (again kindly sent by Lord Northbourne) and the distribution of the presents, among those Convalescents who were in the Home during Christmas-tide, and the staff and friends who were invited to take part in the days amusement. Later on, several friends took part in a Concert, and a Comedietta concluded the evening's doings, which were thoroughly appreciated and enjoyed by all.

Sincere thanks are offered by the Council to the Medical Officers; the Medical Referee, in London; Dr. J. H. F. Wilgress as *locum tenens*, and to Mr. Garnet Ellis, the Honorary Surgeon Dentist, for their services rendered during the year; also to Mr. J. W. Stainer, for several bacteriological examinations.

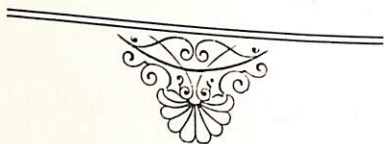

GENERAL INSTRUCTIONS.

OBJECT.

THE object of this Home is the reception and care of convalescent patients after illness (not being of an infectious nature) and accidents; also of those requiring change and rest from their daily employment.

SUBSCRIPTIONS—WHEN DUE, AND HOW PAYABLE.

(For scale of payments and subscriptions see page 29.)

Annual Subscriptions are due on January 1st and July 1st, and letters are available for Twelve Months from these dates. They are to be paid in advance, and no Subscriber is entitled to any privileges whilst his or her Subscription is in arrear. Lost Letters not replaced and overdue Letters not available.

Subscriptions should be sent direct to the Sister Superior; cheques and postal orders payable "to the order of St. Andrew's Home." New Subscribers cannot recommend a case until one month after the payment of the first subscription. Subscribers are especially requested to remember that the amount of a subscription is a Guinea and not a Pound.

ADMISSION OF CASES.

No patient may be sent to the Home until the medical certificate and the form have been fully filled up, and all details have been forwarded to the Sister Superior, and notice has been received from her of the day of admission. Patients whose medical certificates require to be countersigned by the Honorary Medical Referee in London will receive notice of the same.

The admission days are—Monday and Thursday for Women, and Wednesday and Saturday for Men. All patients pay their own travelling expenses, and washing (6d. per week).

The sum to be sent in with a Subscriber's or Donor's Letter is 7s. 6d. for the usual stay of three weeks. With the Letter and this sum, a *stamped and addressed envelope* should be enclosed. There is no payment of 2s. 6d. a week to be sent with Free Bed Letters. The patient's stay is reckoned from the day named on the Notice sent by the Sister Superior, whether the Patient arrives at the Home or not.

PAYING CASES.

The charge, payable in advance, for Board and Lodging of Patients admitted without a Subscriber's Letter is as follows: for Adults, 10s. 6d. per week; for Children under five, 5s.; under nine, 7s.; under fourteen, 9s.

RAILWAY PRIVILEGES.

On production of a voucher signed by the Sister Superior, the South Eastern Railway Co., has liberally arranged for the issue of *monthly* return special Tickets, from their London Stations and Folkestone Junction on payment (at the Railway Booking Office) of 5s. for the double journey. The money for return journeys other than from London, must in all cases be deposited on arrival at the Home.

INELIGIBLE CASES.

Phthisis: those recovering from any infectious or contagious disease; *unvaccinated*, helpless, and unable to walk; of unsound mind, liable to fits or attacks of hysteria, mania, or melancholia persons requiring constant watching or attendance, or by their severe coughing or their painful personal appearance likely to disturb or retard the convalescence of others; of immoral character or of intemperate habits; females in a state of pregnancy; persons under three and above sixty-five years of age. Also those seeking re-admission within twelve months of their discharge, or previously discharged for misconduct. This being a Convalescent Home, *Nurses are not employed.*

LENGTH OF STAY.

Patients are not admitted for less than a fortnight. The usual period is for three weeks, but a patient, if approved by the Medical Officer, may be permitted an extension of time either by payment or by presentation of another Subscriber's Letter, provided it do not unfairly interfere with other patients waiting their turn for admission.

INSTRUCTIONS FOR PATIENTS.

- (a) All payments to be made in advance, and all communications to be addressed to the Sister Superior.
- (b) Patients are not permitted to bring boxes; bags and parcels only allowed. They are required to bring at least one complete change of underclothing, slippers, brush and comb.

- (c) No article of food, drink, or medicine, may be brought into the Home without leave.
- (d) Patients go out with permission from the Ward Sister.
- (e) Any Patient known to enter a public-house, or guilty of gambling, swearing or immoral conversation will be discharged; also, all Patients who are found on arrival to be *uncleanly in head, person or clothes*, will not be allowed to remain in the Home.
- (f) The Patients are expected to assist each other as much as possible, and to make themselves useful if requested to do so by the Sisters.
- (g) Visitors will be admitted to see the Home and the Patients daily (Good Friday excepted) between the hours of 2 and 4, but on Tuesdays and Fridays between 2 and 3 o'clock.
- (h) In order to obtain the blessing of ALMIGHTY GOD upon the Home and its inmates, Patients attend daily prayers morning and evening, and the Services of the Church of England in the Chapel of the Home on Sundays. While in the Home they do not attend other places of worship, except by special permission.

FUNDS.

Donations for the maintenance of the Home are earnestly requested, as subscriptions on behalf of, or payment by Patients, do not cover the cost of their stay in the Home, leaving no margin for all other expenses.

Offertories especially are invited. Reports and circulars of the Home will be gladly forwarded for distribution to any clergyman willing to give an offertory in his Church. Collectors of £2 10s. are entitled to an admission letter for every such sum collected.

All Contributions under a Guinea, though not entitling the giver to a letter of Admission, are most acceptable.

NOTE.—Recommenders of cases are requested to be careful as to the personal cleanliness and also the moral character and temperate habits of the persons they recommend, otherwise it is possible for undesirable persons to be admitted, whose influence is most injurious to the younger patients with whom they associate.
