INTRODUCTION

This document is a transcription from Micro-film records held at the Centre for Kentish Studies at County Hall Maidstone.

It contains a transcription of the Testimony of the Assistant Tithe Commissioner and of the initial Tithe Apportionments made in 1840.

The properties are listed alphabetical by Landowners, although there is an index at the end which lists all owners and occupiers alphabetically.

In addition to the names of the Landowners and Occupiers the schedule contains the property number as shown on the Tithe Map, a description of the property, its cultivation, its area in acres, roods and square perches, the amount of rent payable to the church and where applicable to the Impropiators of the Manor. It also notes where property is exempt from tithes being part of the former estate of the Benedictine Abbey.

TESTIMONY OF ASSISTANT TITHE COMMISSIONER

**Apportionment of the Rent Charge in lieu of Tithes
of the Parish of West Malling in the County of Kent**

WHEREAS an Award of Rent Charge in lieu of tithes of the Parish of West Malling in the County of Kent was on the Sixth day of November in the Year of Our Lord One Thousand Eight Hundred and Forty confirmed by the Tithe Commissioners for England and Wales of which Award with the Schedule therein composed the following as a copy.

KNOW ALL THEN by these Presents that I THOMAS SMITH WOOLLEY of South Collingham in the County of Nottingham having been duly appointed and serve as an Assistant Tithe Commissioner according to the provisions of the Act for the Commutation of Tithes in England and Wales and having been also duly appointed to ascertain and award total sums to be paid by way of Rent Charges instead of Tithes of the Parish of West Malling in the County of Kent. Do hereby award as follows (that is to say

WHEREAS I have held divers meetings in the said parish touching the matter aforesaid of which meetings due notice was given for the information of the Land Owners and Tithe Owners of the said parish;

AND WHEREAS I have duly considered all the allegations and proofs rendered to me by all parties interested and have myself made all inquiries touching the premised subject which appeared to me to be necessary;

AND WHEREAS I find that certain lands of the said Parish of which lands Mathias Prime Lucas of Watlington Place in the said County, Esquire, is Owner the estimated quantity of which lands in Statute Measure amounts to Three Hundred and Twenty Five acres and Twenty perches and the whole of which lands are now cultivated as Woodland and which lands are part of the lands called or known by the name of Malling Abbey Woods are by reason of their having been formerly part and parcel of the possessions of the Benedictine Nuns of the dissolved Abbey of Malling and be enjoyed by the said Nuns at the time of the dissolution of Monasteries, absolutely exempt from the payment of Tithes;

AND WHEREAS I find that certain other lands of the said parish part of the aforesaid lands called or known by the name of Malling Abbey Woods containing by estimation Twenty Seven acres, Three roods and Thirty Five perches and belonging to James Graham of New Barns in the said parish of West Malling, Gentleman, are for the same reasons hereinbefore mentioned absolutely exempt from the payment of Tithes;

AND WHEREAS I find that certain other lands of the said parish part of the aforesaid lands called or known by the name of Malling Abbey Woods containing by estimation One Hundred and Eighteen acres, One rood and Fifteen perches and belonging to John Wells of the said parish of West Malling are for the same reasons hereinbefore mentioned absolutely exempt from the payment of Tithes;

AND WHEREAS I find that certain other lands of the said parish formerly part of the lands called or known by the name of Mallington Woods but now occupied by the Mallington Union Workhouse and the Gardens attached thereto and belonging to the Guardians of the said Union the estimated quantity of which lands amounts to Three acres, Two roods and Twenty perches are for the reasons hereinbefore set forth absolutely exempt from payment of Tithes;

AND WHEREAS I find that certain other lands of the said parish called or known by the name of Preston Grove which lands Philip Honeywood Parsons of the said parish of West Mallington is the Owner and the estimated quantity of in Statute Measure of which amounts to Four acres and Ten perches and which land is now cultivated as woodland and by reason of their having been formerly as aforesaid parcel of the possessions of the Benedictine Nuns of the dissolved Abbey of West Mallington absolutely exempt from payment of Tithes;

AND WHEREAS I find that certain other lands of the said parish the property of Mrs. Anne Losack of Mallington Abbey in the said parish, widow, the estimated quantity in Statute Measure of which lands amounts to Ten acres and Three perches and which lands are divided into five several parcels are by reason of their having been formerly parcel of the possessions of the Benedictine Nuns of the said Abbey of Town Mallington as aforesaid and so enjoyed by the said Nuns at the time of the dissolution of the Monasteries absolutely exempt from payment of Tithes;

AND WHEREAS I find that the estimated quantity in Statute Measure of all the lands in the said parish amounts to One Thousand Three Hundred and Sixty One acres, Ten roods and Twenty perches which are now cultivated as follows (that is to say):

Four Hundred and Ninety Two acres, One rood and Thirty Seven perches as arable land, including the lands now cultivated as Hop Gardens;

One Hundred and Twenty Five acres, Two roods and Sixteen perches as Meadow or Pasture land;

Five Hundred and Eighty Four acres, One rood and Twenty Nine perches as Woodland;

Sixty Seven acres, One rood and Nineteen perches as Gardens, Orchards and Fruit Plantations, including mixed plantations of Fruit and Hops;

Fifty Six acres, Three roods and Twenty Four perches are the sites of houses and buildings and the homesteads and yards and Thirty Five acres, Three roods and Twenty Four perches are the roads and waste of the said parish.

AND WHEREAS I find that all the lands of the said parish, except as hereinbefore excepted are, subject to the payment of all manner of Tithes in kind.

AND WHEREAS I have estimated the clear annual value of the said Tithes in the manner directed by the said Act of Parliament and have also taken into account the rates and assessments paid in respect of the said Tithes during the seven years of average prescribed by the said Act;

AND WHEREAS I find that Silas Norton and George Perfect of the said parish of West Malling, Gentlemen and John Edward Morton of Snodland in the said County of Kent, Trustees in trust under the will of the Late John Banks Esquire deceased are Impropiators and Owners of the Tithes of Corn, Grain and Pulse arising from all the lands of the said parish;

AND WHEREAS I find that the Vicar of the said parish, for the time being, is entitled to all the Tithes except the Tithes of Corn, Grain and Pulse arising from all the lands of the said parish.

NOW KNOW YE that I the said Thomas Smith Woolley do hereby award the annual sum of One Hundred and Fifty pounds by way of Rent Charge, subject to the provisions of the said Act shall from the First Day of October next proceeding the confirmation of the apportionment of the said Rent Charge be paid to the said Silas Norton, George Perfect and John Edward Morton as such Deviseers in trust as aforesaid or to the person who for the time being shall be untitled under the trusts of the said will instead of all Tithes of Corn, Grain and Pulse arising from all the lands of the said parish.

And that a further annual sum of Two Hundred and Three Pounds by way of Ordinary Rent Charge subject to the provision and to commence from the aforesaid shall be paid to the Vicar of the parish for the time being instead of all the Tithes except the Tithes of Corn, Grain, Pulse and Hops arising from all the lands of the said parish except the Vicarial Glebe lands thereof and that a further annual sum of five shillings per acre, and a proportional sum for any quantity less than an acre, by way of Rent Charge subject to the provisions and to commence from the time aforesaid and shall be paid to the said Vicar of the said parish for the time being as aforesaid instead of all the Tithes, except the Tithes of Corn, Grain and Pulse arising from all the Vicarial Glebe lands of the said parish or from such part of the said Glebe Lands as may at any time not be in the occupation of the said Vicar himself.

AND I HEREBY do assign the said parish to be a District within which the undermentioned extraordinary Rent Charge on Hop Grounds shall prevail.

AND I HEREBY further award that all such of the lands of the said District as are now or may be at any time hereinafter cultivated as Hop Grounds shall be charged with and pay to the said Vicar of the said parish for the time being as aforesaid the additional annual sum of Twenty Shillings per Imperial acre and a proportionate sum for any quantity less than an acre by way of extraordinary Rent Charge as long as they shall continue to be so cultivated as Hop Gardens aforesaid.

IN TESTIMONY WHEREOF I have hereunto set my hand this fourth day of November in the year of Our Lord One Thousand Eight Hundred and Forty.
